Peter Ericson Peter is a naturalist specializing in large animal biology, and shares his knowledge with BEST guests.





For over 60 years, the company he founded has





WHERE TO MEET **BEST** & FAQS

Where to Meet

Your BEST River Guide will meet you in the Float Trip Parking Lot in Moose Village, on the west side of the Snake River (see map at left).

Our dark green vans will arrive a few minutes before your scheduled trip. Please be on time, as we are unable to wait for late passengers.



How long does the 10-Mile float trip take?

Total round-trip time is 2.5 to 3 hours.

What times of day do you offer float trips?

BEST Float Trips are offered throughout the day, but launch times vary according to available daylight and river levels. Visit our website or call our office for details.

What should we bring?

- Casual clothing and soft-soled shoes
- Jacket or sweater, and hat with brim
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen and sunglasses
- Camera or binoculars (at your own risk)

What if the weather is bad?

Call our office about an hour before your scheduled departure to confirm your launch, as weather conditions may vary across the valley. We reserve the right to cancel trips due to inclement weather.

What is your Cancellation Policy?

Refunds will be given if BEST cancels your Float Trip due to inclement weather, or if we receive your notice of cancellation at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled trip (72 hours prior for private rafts).
